Subject: No Gift and Gratuity Policy for Official Duties (No Gift Policy) Fiscal Year ๒๐๒๔

The Cabinet approved the national anti-corruption reform plan (revised edition) on December ๘, ๒๐๒๓, outlining key reform activities. Activity ๔ focuses on developing the Thai governmental system to be transparent and free from corruption. Goal ๑.๑ under Activity ๔ mandates that all state agencies declare themselves as organizations where all officials do not accept any kind of gifts or gratuities during the performance of their duties (No Gift Policy).

Don Sila Subdistrict Municipality recognizes the importance of preventing and combating corruption at the local level. We are committed to administering local governance for the benefit and happiness of the local people, adhering to the principles of good municipal management, emphasizing anti-corruption efforts, and promoting community participation. Thus, we declare our commitment as follows: "Don Sila Subdistrict Municipality is an organization where all officials do not accept any kind of gifts or gratuities during the performance of their duties (No Gift Policy) - before, during, and after official duties. On every occasion and festival, to prevent or reduce the likelihood of corruption and misconduct that may affect impartiality or result in various forms of undue benefit. The Municipal Executive, municipal employees, teachers, and all employees will set a good example unless there is an unavoidable necessity. In such cases, they will act in accordance with relevant laws and regulations."
